Silver Fox Scarf

Difficulty level: suitable for the average crocheter

Materials: 2 x 50g Morris and Sons Maya Lace weight, 100% Baby Alpaca.

Needles: Size 1.75mm crochet hook

Size: 22cm x 130cm

Tension: not important.

Abbreviations: **NB** – **British crochet terminology used throughout.**

ch – chain

cluster - *yoh, insert hook as indicated, yoh and draw loop through, yoh and draw through 2 loops, rep from * 3 times more, yoh and draw through all 5 loops on hook;

dc – double crochet

dtr – double treble

yoh – yarn over hook

Using 1.75mm crochet hook make 89ch.

Row 1: 1dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1dc into each ch to the end of the row, turn. (88sts) Row 2: 6ch, 1 cluster into 3rd ch from hook, miss dc at base of 6ch, *miss 2dc, 1dtr into next dc **, 2ch, 1 cluster into top of previous cluster, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, turn.

Now work in pattern as follows:

Row 3: 6ch, 1 cluster into 3rd ch from hook, miss 1 cluster, 1dtr into base of cluster of previous row directly below **, 2 ch, 1 cluster into top of previous cluster of this row, rep from * to end, ending last rep at **, turn.

Repeat row 3 until desired length is reached or two balls of yarn have been used up.

Finishing:

Slightly dampen scarf and block. Leave to dry.

If you want a cowl, sew the two short edges together.
